Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) for English Language Arts and Mathematics aligned to the B.E.S.T. (Benchmarks for Excellent Student Thinking) standards

PREPARING YOUR CHILD FOR FAST ASSESSMENTS

Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) will be administered three times per year in grades VPK through grade 10 English Language Arts and VPK through grade 8 Mathematics. These assessments replace the Florida Standards Assessments (FSA) and are intended to measure student progress in learning B.E.S.T. standards as well as evaluate final student mastery of on-grade level B.E.S.T. standards at the end of the school year.



Test Windows

There are three test windows for FAST assessments during the 2022–2023 school year. (State Assessment Schedule)

- PM1: August 15-September 30, 2022
- PM1 K-2: August 10 September 21, 2022
- PM2: December 5, 2022–January 27, 2023
- PM3: May 1–May 26, 2023

*Specific test administration dates for each grade level and subject area are set at the school.

Grades 3-10 Administration

- Each test will be administered in one session and only one subject a day.
- PM 1 and PM 2 inform instruction and measure student learning based on the BEST Standards.
- PM 3 evaluates student mastery of on-grade level standards and is used for accountability purposes (i.e. student promotion, high school graduation, school grades)
- Tests are taken on a computer and are adaptive.

Grades VPK - 2 Administration

- Each test will be administered in one session and only one subject a day.
- Tests are taken on a computer and are adaptive
- VPK tests are aligned to the Florida Early Learning and Developmental Standards; K-2 tests are aligned to BEST Standards.
